Sports Funding at The Blessed Sacrament

In 2014/15, the school was allocated £9255 in Sports Premium Funding. In addition to this, the school carried forward £5823 from 2013/14 which had not been spent. Details of how the funding was spent are below:

Impact / outcomes

- Staff are increasingly confident in delivering aspects of the PE curriculum (Gymnastics) due to observing a specialist deliver a series of sessions.
- Gymnastics ability of children has improved due to specialist coaching.
- Outdoor play opportunities have widened due to installation of Trim Trail.
- Competitive games can now be played on school grounds due to development of sports pitch.
- Improved storage equipment has enables purchase of outdoor equipment which is now fully accessible.

The school has received a Sports Grant of £9574 for 2015/16. In addition to this, we have carried over £226 from 2014 / 15, making a total of £9,800 available for spend. This money will be used to fund:

- Specialist gymnastics teacher throughout the year for all classes.
- Specialist Dance teacher throughout the year for all classes.
- Specialist Cricket coach delivering session to UKS2.
- Increase swimming provision to 3 terms (usually only a standard 2 terms)
- A new Netball kit
- Increased outdoor adventure sport provision for UKS2 children (orienteering, canoeing)
